HOW MANY BOARD MEMBERS ARE YOU ELECTING?

We currently have three open seats on our fivemember board. Each board member will serve a threeyear term.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS DO I NEED?

To qualify as a Board member of a Special District, a person must be an "eligible elector" which is defined as a **registered voter** of Colorado and either:

- A resident of the District or,
- The owner(or the spouse or civil union partner of the owner) of a taxable real or personal property situated in the District.





THAT'S IT?

Legally, yes. However, serving as a Board member is a commitment both in time and in energy. As a Board member, you're helping to shape an organization that is critical to this community. It's an important job; we can't operate without elected Board members who are willing to volunteer their time and talents.

HOW MUCH OF A TIME COMMITMENT IS THIS?

The EC Paramedics Board of Directors meets on the third Thursday of every month at 3 p.m. Most meetings take about two hours, depending on the business at hand. Additionally, Board members reads and studies the monthly packets to stay up-to-date on the organization. Other time commitments may include attending special events and Board retreats.
